OSCAR® NOMINATIONS FACT SHEET

Best Motion Picture of the Year:

Bugonia (Focus Features) - Ed Guiney & Andrew Lowe, Yorgos Lanthimos, Emma Stone and Lars Knudsen - This is the fourth Best Picture nomination for Ed Guiney, the third for Yorgos Lanthimos and the second for Andrew Lowe and Emma Stone. Together they were all nominated for *Poor Things* (2023). Guiney and Lanthimos were also nominated together for *The Favourite* (2018). Guiney was also nominated for *Room* (2015).

This is the first nomination for Lars Knudsen.

FI (Apple) - Chad Oman, Brad Pitt, Dede Gardner, Jeremy Kleiner, Joseph Kosinski and Jerry Bruckheimer - This is the first nomination for Chad Oman and Joseph Kosinski.

This is the fourth Best Picture nomination for Brad Pitt, who won for *12 Years a Slave* (2013). His other Best Picture nominations were for *Moneyball* (2011) and *The Big Short* (2015).

This is the ninth Best Picture nomination for Dede Gardner and the eighth for Jeremy Kleiner. Together they won Oscars for *12 Years a Slave* (2013) and *Moonlight* (2016), and shared nominations for *Selma* (2014), *The Big Short* (2015), *Vice* (2018), *Women Talking* (2022) and *Nickel Boys* (2024). Gardner was also nominated for *The Tree of Life* (2011).

This is the second Best Picture nomination for Jerry Bruckheimer. He was previously nominated for *Top Gun: Maverick* (2022).

Frankenstein (Netflix) - Guillermo del Toro, J. Miles Dale and Scott Stuber - This is the second Best Picture nomination for Guillermo del Toro and J. Miles Dale. Together they won the award for *The Shape of Water* (2017) and were nominated for *Nightmare Alley* (2021).

This is the first nomination for Scott Stuber.

Hamnet (Focus Features) - Liza Marshall, Pippa Harris, Nicolas Gonda, Steven Spielberg and Sam Mendes - This is the first nomination for Liza Marshall and Nicolas Gonda.

This is the second Best Picture nomination for Pippa Harris and Sam Mendes. Together they were nominated for *1917* (2019).

This is the 14th Best Picture nomination for Steven Spielberg, who won the award for *Schindler's List* (1993). His other nominations were for *E.T. The Extra-Terrestrial* (1982), *The Color Purple* (1985), *Saving Private Ryan* (1998), *Munich* (2005), *Letters from Iwo Jima* (2006), *War Horse* (2011), *Lincoln* (2012), *Bridge of Spies* (2015), *The Post* (2017), *West Side Story* (2021), *The Fabelmans* (2022) and *Maestro* (2023).

Marty Supreme (A24) - Eli Bush, Ronald Bronstein, Josh Safdie, Anthony Katagas and Timothée Chalamet - This is the second Best Picture nomination for Eli Bush, who was nominated for *Lady Bird* (2017).

This is the second Best Picture nomination for Anthony Katagas, who won the award for *12 Years a Slave* (2013).

This is the first Best Picture nomination for Ronald Bronstein, Josh Safdie and Timothée Chalamet.

One Battle after Another (Warner Bros.) - Adam Somner, Sara Murphy and Paul Thomas Anderson - This is the second Best Picture nomination for Adam Somner and Sara Murphy, and the fourth for Paul Thomas Anderson. Together they were nominated for *Licorice Pizza* (2021). Anderson was also nominated for *There Will Be Blood* (2007) and *Phantom Thread* (2017).

The Secret Agent (Neon) - Emilie Lesclaux - This is her first nomination.

Sentimental Value (Neon) - Maria Ekerhovd and Andrea Berentsen Ottmar - This is the first nomination for both.

Sinners (Warner Bros.) - Zinzi Coogler, Sev Ohanian and Ryan Coogler - This is the first nomination for Zinzi Coogler and Sev Ohanian.

This is the second Best Picture nomination for Ryan Coogler. He was nominated for *Judas and the Black Messiah* (2021).

Train Dreams (Netflix) - Marissa McMahon, Teddy Schwarzman, Will Janowitz, Ashley Schlaifer and Michael Heimler - This is the first nomination for Marissa McMahon, Will Janowitz, Ashley Schlaifer and Michael Heimler.

This is the second Best Picture nomination for Teddy Schwarzman. He was nominated for *Whiplash* (2014).

Achievement in Directing:

Hamnet - **Chloé Zhao** - Including her nomination this year for Adapted Screenplay, this is her sixth nomination overall and second in this category. She previously won Oscars for Best Picture and Directing for *Nomadland* (2020) and was nominated for Adapted Screenplay and Film Editing for the same film.

Marty Supreme - **Josh Safdie** – Including his nominations this year for Best Picture, Film Editing and Original Screenplay, this is his fourth nomination overall and first in this category.

One Battle after Another - **Paul Thomas Anderson** - Including his nominations this year for Best Picture and Adapted Screenplay, this is his 14th nomination overall and his fourth in this category. He was nominated for Best Picture and Directing for *There Will Be Blood* (2007), *Phantom Thread* (2017) and *Licorice Pizza* (2021). He was also nominated for his original screenplays for *Boogie Nights* (1997), *Magnolia* (1999) and *Licorice Pizza* (2021) and for his adapted screenplays for *There Will Be Blood* (2007) and *Inherent Vice* (2014).

Sentimental Value - **Joachim Trier** - Including his nominations this year for Best Picture and Original Screenplay, this is his fourth nomination and first in this category. He was previously nominated for Original Screenplay for *The Worst Person in the World* (2021).

Sinners - **Ryan Coogler** - Including his nomination this year for Best Picture and Original Screenplay, this is his fifth nomination overall and first in this category. He was nominated for Best Picture for *Judas and the Black Messiah* (2021) and for the Original Song “Lift Me Up” from *Black Panther: Wakanda Forever* (2022).

Performance by an Actor in a Leading Role:

Timothée Chalamet ("Marty Mauser" in *Marty Supreme*) - This is his third nomination in this category and fourth overall, including his nomination this year for Best Picture. He was nominated for his leading roles in *Call Me by Your Name* (2017) and last year's *A Complete Unknown* (2024).

Leonardo DiCaprio ("Bob" in *One Battle after Another*) - This is his sixth nomination in this category and eighth overall. He won an Oscar for his leading role in *The Revenant* (2015). He was nominated for leading roles in *The Aviator* (2004), *Blood Diamond* (2006), *The Wolf of Wall Street* (2013) and *Once upon a Time...in Hollywood* (2019), and for his supporting role in *What's Eating Gilbert Grape* (1993). He also received a nomination for Best Picture for *The Wolf of Wall Street*.

Ethan Hawke ("Lorenz Hart" in *Blue Moon*) - This is his first nomination in this category and fifth overall. He was nominated for his supporting roles in *Training Day* (2001) and *Boyhood* (2014). He received Adapted Screenplay nominations for *Before Sunset* (2004) and *Before Midnight* (2013).

Michael B. Jordan ("Smoke" and "Stack" in *Sinners*) - This is his first nomination.

Wagner Moura ("Armando," "Marcelo Alves" and "Adult Fernando" in *The Secret Agent*) - This is his first nomination.

Performance by an Actor in a Supporting Role:

Benicio Del Toro ("Sensei Sergio St. Carlos" in *One Battle after Another*) - This is his third nomination. He won an Oscar for his supporting role in *Traffic* (2000) and was nominated for his supporting role in *21 Grams* (2003).

Jacob Elordi ("The Creature" in *Frankenstein*) - This is his first nomination.

Delroy Lindo ("Delta Slim" in *Sinners*) - This is his first nomination.

Sean Penn ("Col. Steven J. Lockjaw" in *One Battle after Another*) - This is his sixth nomination and first in this category. He won Oscars for his leading roles in *Mystic River* (2003) and *Milk* (2008). He was nominated for his leading roles in *Dead Man Walking* (1995), *Sweet and Lowdown* (1999) and *I Am Sam* (2001).

Stellan Skarsgård ("Gustav Borg" in *Sentimental Value*) - This is his first nomination.

Performance by an Actress in a Leading Role:

Jessie Buckley ("Agnes" in *Hamnet*) - This is her second nomination and first in this category. She was nominated for her supporting role in *The Lost Daughter* (2021).

Rose Byrne ("Linda" in *If I Had Legs I'd Kick You*) - This is her first nomination.

Kate Hudson ("Claire" in *Song Sung Blue*) - This is her second nomination and first in this category. She was nominated for her supporting role in *Almost Famous* (2000).

Renate Reinsve ("Nora Borg" in *Sentimental Value*) - This is her first nomination.

Emma Stone ("Michelle" in *Bugonia*) - Including her nomination this year for Best Picture, this is her seventh nomination overall and third nomination in this category. She won Oscars for her leading roles in *La La Land* (2016) and *Poor Things* (2023). She was nominated for her supporting roles in *Birdman or (The Unexpected Virtue of Ignorance)* (2014) and *The Favourite* (2018). She also received a Best Picture nomination for *Poor Things* (2023).

Performance by an Actress in a Supporting Role:

Elle Fanning ("Rachel Kemp" in *Sentimental Value*) - This is her first nomination.

Inga Ibsdotter Lilleaas ("Agnes Borg Pettersen" in *Sentimental Value*) - This is her first nomination.

Amy Madigan ("Gladys" in *Weapons*) - This is her second nomination. She was nominated for her supporting role in *Twice in a Lifetime* (1985).

Wunmi Mosaku ("Annie" in *Sinners*) - This is her first nomination.

Teyana Taylor ("Perfidia" in *One Battle after Another*) - This is her first nomination.

Adapted Screenplay:

Bugonia - Screenplay by **Will Tracy** (based on the film *Save the Green Planet!* Written by Jang Joon Hwan) - This is his first nomination.

Frankenstein - Written for the Screen by **Guillermo del Toro** (based on the book *Frankenstein; or, The Modern Prometheus* by Mary Shelley) - Including his nomination this year for Best Picture, this is his eighth nomination overall and third in a writing category. He previously won Oscars for Best Picture and Directing for *The Shape of Water* (2017) and for Animated Feature Film for *Guillermo del Toro's Pinocchio* (2022). He was nominated for his original screenplays for *Pan's Labyrinth* (2006) and *The Shape of Water* (2017) and for Best Picture for *Nightmare Alley* (2021).

Hamnet - Screenplay by **Chloé Zhao & Maggie O'Farrell** (based on the novel written by Maggie O'Farrell) - Including her nomination this year for Directing, this is the sixth nomination overall and second in a writing category for Chloé Zhao. She previously won Oscars for Best Picture and Directing for *Nomadland* (2020) and was nominated for Adapted Screenplay and Film Editing for the same film.

This is the first nomination for Maggie O'Farrell.

One Battle after Another - Written by **Paul Thomas Anderson** (inspired by the novel *Vineland* by Thomas Pynchon) - Including his nominations this year for Best Picture and Directing, this is his 14th nomination overall and his sixth in a writing category. He was previously nominated for his original screenplays for *Boogie Nights* (1997), *Magnolia* (1999) and *Licorice Pizza* (2021) and his adapted screenplays for *There Will Be Blood* (2007) and *Inherent Vice* (2014). He was also nominated for Best Picture and Directing for *There Will Be Blood* (2007), *Phantom Thread* (2017) and *Licorice Pizza* (2021).

Train Dreams - Screenplay by **Clint Bentley & Greg Kwedar** (based on the novella by Denis Johnson) - This is the second nomination for both. Together they were nominated for Adapted Screenplay for last year's *Sing Sing* (2024).

Original Screenplay:

Blue Moon - Written by **Robert Kaplow** - This is his first nomination.

It Was Just an Accident - Written by **Jafar Panahi**; Script collaborators - **Nader Saïvar, Shadmehr Rastin, Mehdi Mahmoudian** - This is the first nomination for all four.

Marty Supreme - Written by **Ronald Bronstein & Josh Safdie** - This is the first nomination for both.

Sentimental Value – Written by **Eskil Vogt, Joachim Trier** - This is the fourth nomination for Joachim Trier and the second for Eskil Vogt. Together they were nominated for their original screenplay for *The Worst Person in the World* (2021). Trier is also nominated this year for Best Picture and Directing.

Sinners - Written by **Ryan Coogler** - Including his nominations this year for Best Picture and Directing, this is his fifth nomination overall and first in a writing category. He was previously nominated for Best Picture for *Judas and the Black Messiah* (2021) and for the Original Song “Lift Me Up” from *Black Panther: Wakanda Forever* (2022).

International Feature Film:

The Secret Agent (Brazil) [Directed by Kleber Mendonça Filho.] - This is the sixth nomination for Brazil. Other nominations were for *Keeper of Promises (The Given Word)* (1962), *O Quatrilho* (1995), *Four Days in September* (1997), *Central Station* (1998) and *I'm Still Here* (2024), which won last year's award.

It Was Just an Accident (France) [Directed by Jafar Panahi.] - This is the 40th nomination for France. It has taken home nine Oscars for *My Uncle* (1958), *Black Orpheus* (1959), *Sundays and Cybele* (1962), *A Man and a Woman* (1966), *The Discreet Charm of the Bourgeoisie* (1972), *Day for Night* (1973), *Madame Rosa* (1977), *Get Out Your Handkerchiefs* (1978) and *Indochine* (1992). Additionally, France received three Special/Honorary Awards prior to the establishment of a regular award category in 1956: for *Monsieur Vincent* (1948), *The Walls of Malapaga* (1950) [shared with Italy] and *Forbidden Games* (1952). Other nominations were for *Gervaise* (1956), *Gates of Paris* (1957), *La Vérité* (1960), *The Umbrellas of Cherbourg* (1964), *Live for Life* (1967), *Stolen Kisses* (1968), *My Night at Maud's* (1969), *Hoa-Binh* (1970), *Lacombe, Lucien* (1974), *Cousin, Cousine* (1976), *A Simple Story* (1979), *The Last Metro* (1980), *Coup de Torchon (“Clean Slate”)* (1982), *Entre Nous* (1983), *Three Men and a Cradle* (1985), *Betty Blue* (1986), *Au Revoir Les Enfants (Goodbye, Children)* (1987), *Camille Claudel* (1989), *Cyrano de Bergerac* (1990), *Ridicule* (1996), *East-West* (1999), *The Taste of Others* (2000), *Amélie* (2001), *The Chorus (Les Choristes)* (2004), *Joyeux Noël* (2005), *The Class* (2008), *A Prophet* (2009), *Mustang* (2015), *Les Misérables* (2019) and *Emilia Pérez* (2024).

Sentimental Value (Norway) [Directed by Joachim Trier.] - This is the seventh nomination for Norway. Previous nominations were for *Nine Lives* (1957), *Pathfinder* (1987), *The Other Side of Sunday* (1996), *Elling* (2001), *Kon-Tiki* (2012) and *The Worst Person in the World* (2021).

Sirāt (Spain) [Directed by Oliver Laxe.] - This is the 22nd nomination for Spain. It has won the award four times: for *Volver a Empezar* (1982), *Belle Epoque* (1993), *All about My Mother* (1999) and *The Sea Inside* (2004). Other nominations were for *La Venganza* (1958), *Plácido* (1961), *Los Tarantos* (1963), *El Amor Brujo* (1967), *Tristana* (1970), *My Dearest Señorita* (1972), *That Obscure Object of Desire* (1977), *Mama Turns a Hundred* (1979), *The Nest* (1980), *Carmen* (1983), *Double Feature* (1984), *Course Completed* (1987), *Women on the Verge of a Nervous Breakdown* (1988), *Secrets of the Heart* (1997), *The Grandfather* (1998), *Pain and Glory* (2019) and *Society of the Snow* (2023).

The Voice of Hind Rajab (Tunisia) [Directed by Kaouther Ben Hania.] - This is the second nomination for Tunisia. Its previous nomination was for *The Man Who Sold His Skin* (2020).

Animated Feature Film:

Arco (Neon) - Ugo Bienvenu, Félix de Givry, Sophie Mas and Natalie Portman - This is the first nomination for Ugo Bienvenu, Félix de Givry and Sophie Mas.

This is the first nomination in this category and fourth overall for Natalie Portman.

Elio (Walt Disney) - Madeline Sharafian, Domee Shi, Adrian Molina and Mary Alice Drumm - This is the second nomination for Madeline Sharafian. She was nominated for her animated short film *Burrow* (2020).

This is the third nomination for Domee Shi. She won an Oscar for her animated short film *Bao* (2018) and was nominated for Animated Feature Film for *Turning Red* (2022).

This is the first nomination for Adrian Molina and Mary Alice Drumm.

KPop Demon Hunters (Netflix) - Maggie Kang, Chris Appelhans and Michelle L. M. Wong - This is the first nomination for all three.

Little Amélie or the Character of Rain (GKIDS) – Mailys Vallade, Liane-Cho Han, Nidia Santiago and Henri Magalon – This is the first nomination for all four.

Zootopia 2 (Walt Disney) - Jared Bush, Byron Howard and Yvett Merino - This is the second nomination for Jared Bush and Yvett Merino and the fourth for Byron Howard. Together all three of them won an Oscar for Animated Feature Film for *Encanto* (2021). Howard also won an Oscar for Animated Feature Film for *Zootopia* (2016) and was nominated for *Bolt* (2008).
